A wild-eyed clown with plans for getting ahead in his business takes matters into his own hands. From the very first opening scene of the one-man show “*Tengo un Arma*” (“I Have a Gun!”) desperation is evident in Farolín, the clown who has “a perfect life, a lovely wife and a great kid.” Unfortunately things don’t go quite right – his wife doesn’t really love him, his kid “disrespects” him as a has-been and his mother-in-law thinks he’s just a lazy bastard.

In this show, playwright Alberto Sosa presents his most recent award-winning three-act play reflecting certain uncomfortable, perhaps unspoken, realities of life beyond the fringe. The dark comedy releases a flow of energy that overtakes the participant as much as it does Farolín. Already produced in 12 different states in Mexico, “*Tengo un Arma!*” won the National Monologue Award.

Don’t wait outside – get a move-on, if you dare!
